



Sebring International Raceway Testing Event – October 15, 2026 Load-In & Schedule

Waivers & Driver Info All participants must complete the Max Track Time Driver Info & Electronic Waiver prior to arrival. The team captain/registrant is expected to distribute this waiver to all drivers and crew.

Load-In Assisted load-in will be on Wednesday, October 14th 5:30 PM - 9 PM. Max Track Time participants may park their race cars, haulers, and street vehicles in the Sebring paddock (see Facility/Paddock Maps section). Prior to load-in, teams may stage their trucks in the staging lanes inside Gate 1 via Haywood Taylor Blvd. starting at 9 AM.

Note: WRL load in will begin at 2 PM on Thursday, October 15th. Please ensure your rig/equipment is setup in the space you intend to use during the race weekend and is not occupying additional spaces.

Load-Out All drivers/teams not participating in the WRL weekend must exit the Sebring garage area by 5:30 PM on Thursday, October 15th and must exit the paddock by 7:00 PM.

Garages Fuel in pit lane must be stored against the pit wall and may not be stored in the covered terrace area behind pit road. A maximum of two drums may be stored behind the pit wall per pit stall. All other fuel must be stored in the paddock.

RV Camping Reservations For any teams wishing to camp at the track, please contact <u>WRL</u>. Water hookups are limited. No dump station on property. Please see the paddock map below for the designated RV parking areas.

Electrical Hookups Teams requiring electrical hookups may purchase a band for \$100 for the weekend at the Gate 1 security shack prior to load-in.

Registration/Driver's Meeting Registration and a short drivers meeting will be hosted in the Gallery of Legends building on Thursday, October 15th. Registration will be open from 7:00 AM – 7:30 AM in the Gallery of Legends with the Mandatory Driver Meeting at 7:30 AM. If a driver misses the driver meeting, a second meeting will be held at 9:00 AM. Half-day registration will open at 12:00 PM in the Gallery of Legends with a Mandatory Driver Meeting at 12:30 PM. All participating drivers must sign in and present or sign the provided waivers at check in. Please See Minor Driver section below for drivers under 18 years of age.

7:00 PM – All non-WRL participants must exit the paddock by this time





Event Requirements

Cars Entrants are expected to prepare their car for the duties of track driving to the minimum standard outlined in our <u>Tech Guide</u>. Should a car be suspected of not being safe for track use, the organizers reserve the right to deny track access at any point during the event. Drivers All drivers in race cars must have full racing gear including: Nomex Suit, SA2015/FIA2018 or newer Helmet, Racing Shoes, Balaclava, Nomex Socks, HANS device or comparable neck protection. Street car drivers must have a helmet meeting the above specification, long pants, and closed toed shoes. HANS devices are required in street cars with racing harnesses. Failure to have appropriate driving gear will result in denial of track access until appropriate gear is obtained.

MINORS Minors aged 16-17 are permitted to drive provided they have filled out our minor waiver. A legal parent or guardian must either be present, or have the waiver signed, notarized, and presented at the event for the minor to participate.

Track Rules

Any scooters must have an affixed and appropriate seat to be operated in the paddock.

All attendees wishing to enter the hot pit area must wear long pants and closed-toed shoes. Improper attire will bar entrants from pitlane.

Minors wishing to be in the pit area, garage area, trackside communications stations, and any other location defined as the "Track Area" must also sign the minor waivers.

TRACK DAMAGE Drivers/teams are financially responsible for any damage that they cause to racetrack property including, but not limited to, tire barriers guard rails and posts. Additionally, any absorbent material used to clean up after spills or fire suppression equipment expended will be billed to the driver of the car. Teams are required to place pads or boards below any jacks, trailer landings, or motorcycle kickstands in the paddock. Failure to do so will result in fees to repair the damaged asphalt.

Fuel Sebring stocks VP 93, 98, and 110 octane fuel at their on-site fuel station. The pumps accept credit card and cash and will be open from 7:30 AM – 4:30 PM. For teams ordering fuel, teams must take the barrel with them. Teams leaving fuel barrels behind will be charged \$25 each for disposal.

Tire Support Continental Tire will support tire changes for our event beginning on Thursday, October 15th at 12:00 PM.

Nitrogen/Air Sebring will stage all nitrogen/air deliveries in the back paddock near the center of the paddock against the wall nearest the back straight.

Concrete Blocks Any teams requiring concrete blocks for their awnings may purchase these at the fuel pumps. To reserve concrete blocks for delivery at load-in, please contact Corey Compton at ccompton@sebringraceway.com

Packages / Shipping Any packages shipped to the track will be available for pickup at the shipping/receiving building on Midway Drive on the inside of Turn 1 between the hours of 8 AM - 5 PM each day.
